AP should be on your short list for back-office automation

Modernizing your AP processes and the way you pay your suppliers can dramatically improve the efficiency of your back-office operations and deliver tremendous ROI. Automation can transform this function from a manual, error-prone cost center into a streamlined and strategic function.

For small and mid-sized businesses, AP automation can deliver substantial ROI within 12 months by reducing invoice and payment processing times and costs, improving cash flow, and enhancing your supplier relationships.



Manual AP: A slow drain without a stopper

AP teams typically spend between four and 18 people days per month on their AP process. For mid-sized businesses, those numbers lean heavily toward the high end of that range.

The drivers behind those time commitments vary for each organization, but the time spent on AP is likely a result of manual data entry and payment execution, disconnected and siloed systems, decentralized supplier information management, and approval workflow bottlenecks.

Invoice ingestion is likely the number one time driver for manual AP processes.

According to one survey, this breaks down to:

75% receive invoices by email.*

65% receive paper invoices.*

65% enter invoice details manually.*

All these inefficiencies make it difficult to scale your team without adding headcount.

But the issue is much more than time.

If you're still paying your suppliers by check, your processing costs may be as much as **40-50% higher** compared to businesses using digital payments.

You may also be losing out on early payment discounts from suppliers; not to mention valuable cash rebates available through digital payment methods like Virtual Cards. And if you're using check float time as a form of cash flow management, this can actually cost more than the perceived benefits of the float.

Limited visibility and financial control, as well as poor audit readiness can also be a challenge. This weakens your value to the organization overall — and hurts the business.

How much manual AP processes are costing you

Research from the American Productivity and Quality Center (APQC) highlights key metrics related to AP processes across different performance tiers, underscoring the benefits of AP automation.

Performance tier	Cost per invoice	Average days payable outstanding (DPO)	Time from receipt of invoice to scheduled payment	Savings potential
Top performers (25th percentile)	\$1.42	30 days	5 days	Potential savings of \$450,000 for every 100,000 invoices processed by moving from bottom to top performance.

Support data-driven decisions and continuous improvement with dashboard visibility. View metrics like days payable outstanding, processing cost per invoice, and discount capture rates, as well as real-time visibility into liabilities and payment statuses.

Integration matters

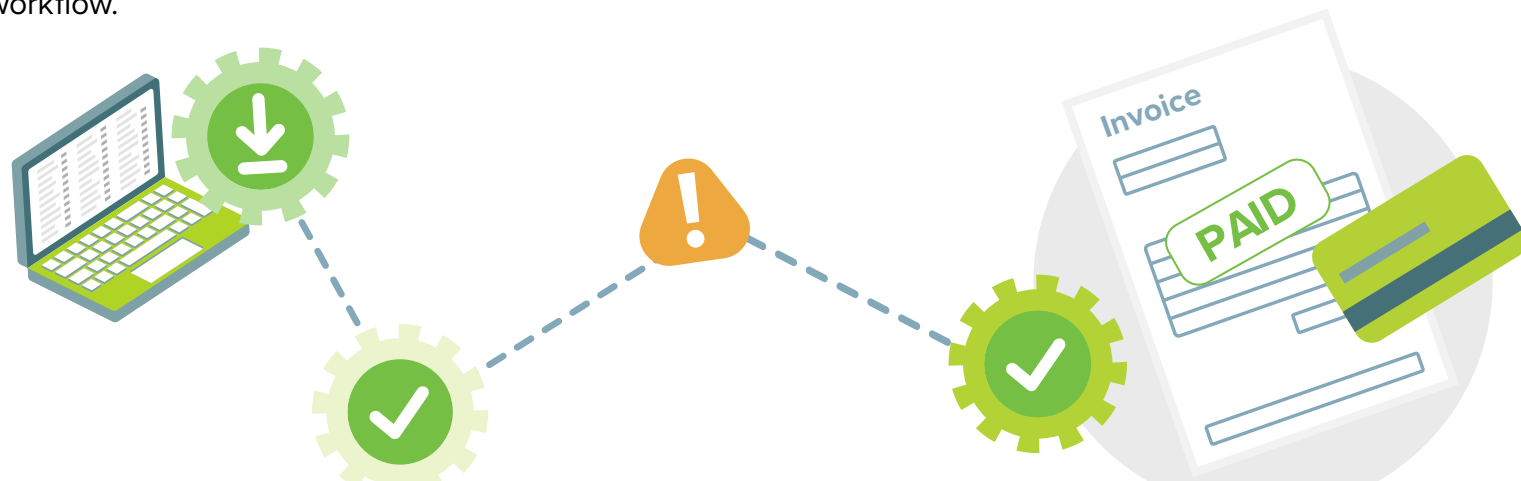
AP automation adds big value across the finance function. However, that value may be limited if you can't connect that automation with the other financial systems you are already using for approval, payment, and audit workflows. When automated AP capabilities are tightly integrated with your enterprise financial systems, it solves a host of challenges for your business and multiplies the benefits for your finance team and the business:

Automate the full end-to-end AP process

Some ERPs automate aspects of the AP process, but there are often critical gaps in the end-to-end workflow, such as missing payment functionality. ERP approval permissions are not available to every employee by design, making it difficult to automate specific steps. Even with proper access, it can be challenging, especially remotely. With the right AP automation solution, you can automate all of these steps, without having to give the entire organization elevated ERP credentials. Approvers can check and validate invoices directly from their email inbox in one easy workflow.

Gain full visibility into pending invoices

Typically, an invoice is only posted to the ERP once it is coded and approved. That means your team has limited visibility into pending invoices stuck in approval queues and their impact on cash flow. A dedicated AP automation solution allows you to see all invoices as they're captured, so you know what's coming. This allows your team to use invoice data for financial forecasting or accruals, before it's actually posted to the system.





Build easy invoice approval processes

Approvers don't need to navigate complicated ERP interfaces with special approval credentials to validate invoice payments. Instead, they can submit approvals via email or within the AP automation solution. Additionally, reminders to approve invoices are sent automatically, reducing time spent by the AP team in following up.

Improve visibility and supplier relationships

For many businesses, supplier relationships are becoming more strategic. Modern AP automation solutions help users easily find the payment status of each invoice and respond to supplier inquiries. You can also set up automated notifications to suppliers regarding invoice receipt, approval, and payment initiation. This frees up time for your AP team and enhances the relationship with your suppliers.

Use a single payment module

With ERPs, finance teams must manage each integration workflow separately. Modern AP automation can implement several payment types into a single integrated workflow, no matter the preferred payment type. Newer embedded payment options allow you to pay bills via each supplier's preferred payment method directly within your ERP environment.

Accurately capture invoices

Many ERP systems also provide invoice capture, but only input the invoice header details, or are typically far less accurate than dedicated AP automation solutions that pair OCR technology with human review. Some dedicated AP solutions accurately capture individual line items on the invoice and achieve 99.5% accuracy.

Support remote and hybrid work


Because you likely receive invoices via different channels, invoice collaboration tools allow different approvers to electronically share notes and collaborate on invoices, anytime, anywhere.

Maintain your ERP as the system of record

Tight integration between your ERP and AP automation systems ensures that your ERP system remains the system of record and your single source of truth for accounting. All payment data stays securely within the existing system for a complete, real-time view of your payables for seamless financial management.

Scale without adding headcount

Enrolling suppliers is a big challenge in setting up digital payments. Look for an AP automation solution augmented by complementary services that can help enroll and onboard your suppliers to accept digital payments — whether it's ACH or virtual cards. This allows your businesses to drive adoption and take better advantage of early-pay discounts and cash-back rebates. All without adding headcount.

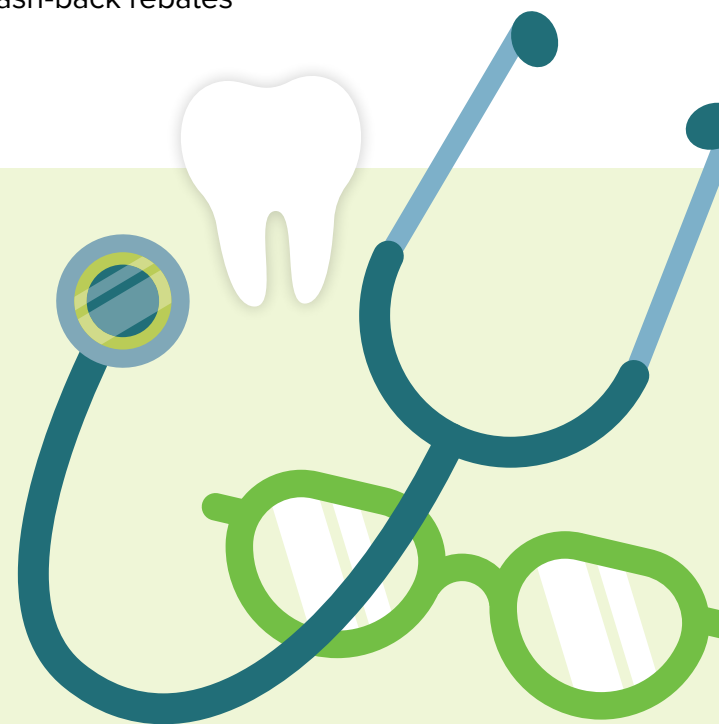
